A suite in a tower. Immersed in history. Four exceptional locations where a new luxury concept can be experimented: a pause from the daily rush in order to rediscover the notion of silence, protected by ancient walls and surrounded by the fascination of a past that seems to have remained intact. In Umbria, a few kilometers from the village of Montone in the province of Perugia there stands the Torre di Moravola, a watchtower with a breathtaking view that the architect Christopher Chong and the designer Seonaid Mackenzie have restored to its primitive beauty. The seven exclusive suites, with swimming pool, gardens and terraces, have a linear and contemporary style that contrasts agreeably with the might of the medieval structures. A mix of family furniture and design pieces characterizes the suites of another historic residence, Torre Almonte, situated near Todi in the splendid Umbrian countryside. The tower is surrounded by a centuries-old park with an nineteenth-century garden and a collection of antique roses. From a romantic bedroom in the small tower in Locanda dell'Amorosa in Sinalunga there's a wonderful view of the Siennese hills. Locanda is an ancient hamlet with a renaissance square and an unforgettable restaurant, and is set in the sweet, serene Tuscan landscape. Finally, a city tower, the "Ripa dei Prendiparte", proudly stands high in the heart of medieval Bologna. It has twelve carefully restored floors, the first three of which have been transformed into a complete apartment where you can take shelter and enjoy the feeling of "fleeing from the world".
